# VIGILANTE ROLE

- Vigilance over
  1. Village level institutions
  2. Civil works executed in the village
  3. Flagship Programmes of Central and State Gov  
ernments

# 1. INSTITUTIONAL VIGILANCE

- 5 Key cutting edge village level institutions
  - School
  - Anganwadi Centre
  - Health Sub Centre
  - FP Shop
  - Welfare Hostels

# Role of BNVs –Village School

- Achieving 100% enrollment of children in the age group of 5-14 years
- Retention
- Ensuring the regularity of attendance/punctuality of teachers
- Ensuring that quality of learning is maintained as per the learning ladder
- Ensure proper implementation of Mid Day Meal Programme

# Role of BNVs –Village School

- Proper utilisation of School Grants under SSA
  - Every school receives the following grants annually
    - School grant of Rs.5000/-
    - Maintenance grant Rs.5000/ 7000
    - Teacher's Grant –Rs.500/- per teacher
    - TLM grant for few select schools
- BNVs should ensure that the above grants are properly utilised and accounted by the school

# Role of BNVs-Health Sub Centre

- Ensuring the regularity of attendance/visits of ANMs and ASHA workers
- Ensuring 100% institutional deliveries
- Ensuring grants under NRHM are properly utilised
  - Sub Centre untied funds - Rs.10000/-
  - Village sanitation fund –Rs.10000/-

# Role of BNV-Anganwadi Centre

- Ensuring the regularity of attendance of AWW
- Ensuring the enrollment of all pregnant women/lactating mothers and eligible children
- Pre and ante natal care
- Ensuring proper supply of nutritious food at Anganwadi centre

# Role of BNVs-FP Shop

- Ensuring proper supply of ration by ration dealer

## 2. VIGILANCE OVER CIVIL WORKS

- BNVs should exercise vigilance over the execution of civil works at village level
- Pre execution stage-estimates should be read out to gramsabha in people's language
- Execution Stage-supervision of arrival of material, quality of construction
- Post Execution-Social audit of expenditure incurred, wall boards detailing the expenditure

# 3. VIGILANCE OVER FLAGSHIP PROGRAMMES

- NREGA
  - Ensure that all eligible wage seekers get job cards
  - Facilitate identification of suitable works
  - Ensure that all willing house holds get 100 days of employment
  - Ensure payment of wages in a stipulated time
  - Participate in social audit
- NRHM, SSA, MDM- BNVs role already

# MOTIVATIONAL ROLE

- Ensuring 100% enrollment of children in the age group of 5-14 years
- Achieving 100% ISL construction in the village
- Achieving 100% enrollment and regular attendance under adult education programme/Saakshar Bharat
- Achieving 100% institutional deliveries, immunisation and family planning
- Achieving total prohibition of liquor

# FACILITATORY ROLE

- Facilitate the attached households to access government schemes to which they are entitled
- Facilitate the attached house holds to access services like birth/death, caste, nativity, income certificates from government offices
- Facilitate grievance redressal by bringing legitimate grievances of the attached households to the notice of the concerned

What BNVs should achieve after

- Achieve 100% enrollment of children in the age group of 5-14 years **one year**
- Achieve 100% institutional deliveries
- Achieve 100% pre and ante natal care for pregnant women and lactating mothers
- Achieve 100% Family Planning
- Achieve 100% immunisation
- Achieve 100% ISL coverage and Total eradication of Open Defecation in the

1. No remuneration-Voluntarism is the foundation of the strategy
2. Should not be part of the establishment
3. Should not have any political affiliation
4. Should not be asked to collect data/information
5. Should not be asked to make village level plans as that is the domain of Gram Panchayat
